NICK MOSBY ANNOUNCES RUN FOR MAYOR OF BALTIMORE

Outlines Vision Safer Streets, Better Schools, Better Police-Community Relations, More Accountable and Transparent City Government & New Opportunity for All

BALTIMORE, MD (October 25, 2015) – Councilman Nick J. Mosby formally announced his candidacy for Mayor of the City of Baltimore.

Joined by friends and supporters in West Baltimore, Mosby declared his candidacy, stating *“I’m running because we need a Mayor with new energy, new ideas, and a commitment to new opportunity for all of our citizens.”*

Councilman Nick Mosby was elected to the Baltimore City Council in November 2011, and represents a diverse group of neighborhoods in the 7th District of West Baltimore. A multigenerational Baltimorean, Mosby outlined his vision to demand better schools and safer streets on behalf of the citizens of Baltimore.

During his remarks, Mosby declared,

“As a father raising two young girls in West Baltimore, you can count on me to fight for better schools, safer streets, more jobs, a transparent government, and better police-community relations.”

Mosby also called for an audit of the City budget to find and stamp out fraud, waste, and abuse, and the use of body cameras by the Baltimore City Police Department to improve community relations. Mosby also called for the strengthening of Early Childhood Education in the city, and expanding access to community college and vocational training for Baltimore City residents.

“We will demand better by requiring that all police on patrol wear body cameras immediately...

“We will demand better by establishing an Early Childhood Education Task Force with the mission of reaching every at-risk child in this city and ensuring they are enrolled in certified programs...

“We will demand better by getting funding for free community college for all Baltimore residents who want to improve themselves and learn new skills.”
